
Is your patient likely to have a prolonged need for ventilation?

What is the UK NAVA trial:

It compares the use of Neurally Adjusted Ventilatory Assist (NAVA) technology to standard ventilatory support alone.

NAVA monitoring; provides real-time insight into the patient's neural respiratory drive in any mode.

NAVA mode; delivers pressure support that is proportional and synchronous to the patient's diaphragm activity.

UK NAVA is a trial for:

- Adults
- Expected to need invasive ventilation for at least 48 hours
- Expected weaning difficulty (any acute or chronic clinical risk factor for difficult weaning from invasive ventilation)
